## Installation

1. Deactivate any Magento cache and compiler (if active)
2. Un-compress the module to your Magento root directory
3. Log out and log back to admin

The template files to be copied are:

- frontend/default/default/layout/j2tautoadd.xml
- frontend/default/default/template/j2tautoadd

## How to setup a “Promo Extend” rule

In order to setup a rule within with J2T Promo Extend extension capability, you have to:

1. Log into the admin
2. Go in promotion tab
3. Click on “Shopping Cart Rule” (fig. 1)
4. Click on “Add New” button (fig. 2)
5. “Specify Coupon” as Coupon setup (fig. 3) and optionally use Auto Generation if you would like to manually generate coupons or from cronjob, according to Promo Extend conditions
6. Activate “Promo Extend” feature (fig. 4)

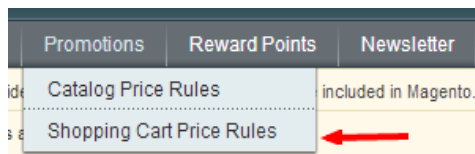

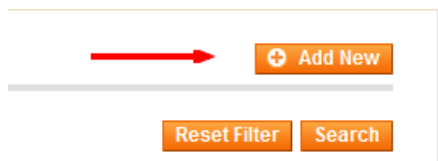

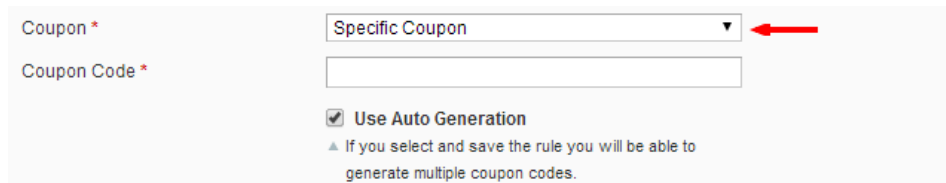

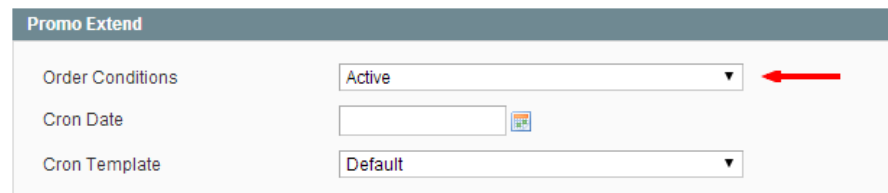

From this point, you can now define a cron date (if auto generation is configure) and you will have access to Orders Condition tab while you will save the rule.

## Orders' conditions Tab

This tab is provided by our module and will allow you to define conditions that would be applied to previously placed orders.

### Bases of orders' conditions tab

There would be few possibilities while creating a new condition (fig. 5):

- Number of orders
- Invoiced subtotal
- Invoiced total
- Subtotal
- Subtotal Inc. Tax
- Grand Total

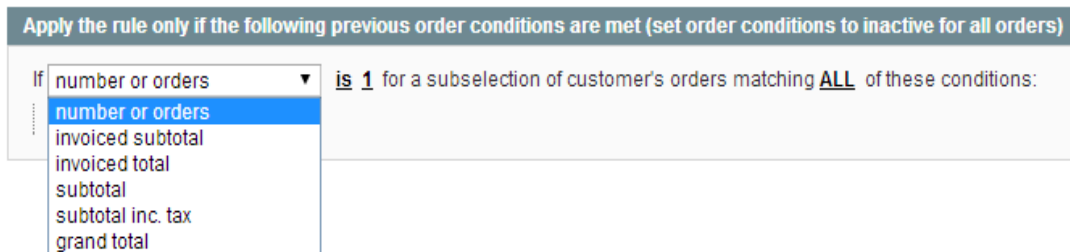

### Module condition specificity

Our module contains few particularities, which differentiate it from default rule condition from Magento.

You will be able to define:

- Order date. You can define a specific date or eventually define date range (fig. 6)
- Order status. (fig. 6)

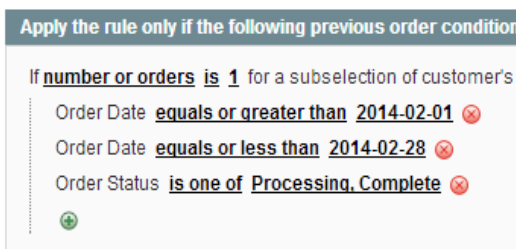

## Coupon code generation

### Generate actions

With J2T Promo Extend, it is possible to manually generate coupon codes in different ways (fig. 7):

- Default. Coupons will be generated according to quantity you will define. However, this method doesn't check the orders' conditions and doesn't link the coupon to a customer
- Generate / Orders' conditions verification. Max quantity of coupons are generated.
- Generate / Orders' conditions verification / Send Emails. Max quantity of coupons are generated and email are sent.

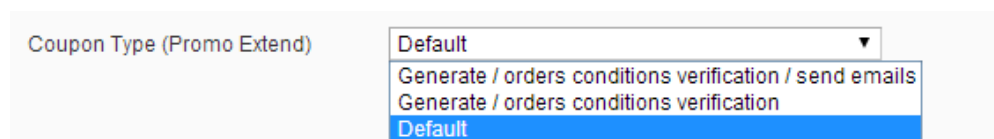

**Important:** If Generate options are chosen and orders' conditions don't meet, the following message will appear: "Not valid data provided".

Also note that coupon is only generated once per rule and per customer. In order to generate a new one, it is required to remove a linked customer's coupon first.

### Grid actions

It is possible to manually send email trough coupon's grid (Fig. 8)

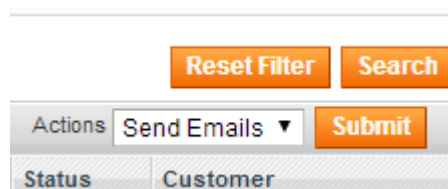
